who redeems us
by His own blood
and secures for us
the forgiveness of our sins.

Through Christ –
God saves His chosen ones -- by grace thru faith –
Making those who were dead in trespasses and sins ALIVE forevermore!! –
And with Him forever!

And raising them to unimaginable heights in Christ Jesus.

In Christ -- God is reconciling all things and all peoples to Himself,

Paul says....

[Ephesians 4 (ESV)] [Unity In the Body of Christ]

1 I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called,

As we've seen...this Calling is – spectacular, divine, cosmic, eternal, breath-taking...

....and it's the calling of everyone who has been placed "IN CHRIST" by faith – every Christian!

...Yes, even those in Gardner, MA!

...with such an amazing and gracious calling, From the Creator of the Universe...

...What kind of response could we possibly give other than:

- -- the glad surrender of our entire lives,
- --full, unreserved commitment, and ...
- --The most sincere dedication and devotion we could muster

Nothing else would do.... Because ...

- --Look Who's calling!
- --Look what He's giving!
- --Look at the PRICE its's costing Him to accomplish it!

"LORD -- WE ARE YOURS!

"SAY THE WORD!—
NO REQUEST IS TOO GREAT!

"WE YEARN

TO GIVE OURSELVES TO YOU! "WE DELIGHT TO BE YOURS FORVER!

GROWING TOGETHER IN CHRIST - IN <u>UNITY</u>....

....Requires Christ-like character & attitudes toward one another

-Verse 2:

"...with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, "

"**HUMILITY**" – like Jesus Christ who humbled Himself and became obedient to death, even death on a cross (Phil. 2).

...Humility involves humbling oneself before God and seeing Him as Big and Worthy of all our trust, love and obedience—

--- Jesus Always had this attitude toward the Father:

John 4:34

34 Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to accomplish his work.

John 5:30

30 "I can do nothing on my own. As I hear, I judge, and my judgment is just, because I seek not my own will but the will of him who sent me.

John 6:38

38 For I have come down from heaven, not to do my own will but the will of him who sent me.

John 7:16

16 So Jesus answered them, "My teaching is not mine, but his who sent me.

John 8:26-29

....He who sent me is true, and I declare to the world what I have heard from Him."

 \dots "When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing on my own authority, but speak just as the Father taught me. \dots

... He has not left me alone, for I always do the things that are pleasing to him."

"Humility" humbles oneself before **others**, willingly sacrificing what is rightfully ours in order to bring good and blessing to others. Sound familiar? – Like JESUS.

"GENTLENESS"—

--patiently enduring offence, w/o malice or desire for revenge.

--one of the Fruit of the Spirit – which is a catalog of Christ-likeness

"PATIENCE"—

- --also one of the 9 fruit listed in Galatians, belonging to Jesus,
- -- and those in whom His spirit lives.
- --AKA: LONG-Suffering
- --because that's what it does—
- --It suffers long...w/o complaining or becoming angry and bitter.
- --It does so because it trusts in God who it knows really is in control:
- -Gen 50:20 "you intended...

"BEARING WITH ONE ANOTHER IN LOVE"--

- --Enduring with someone and their shortcoming, until the provocation is past.
- --We know that can sometimes be a Long Time
- -- In LOVE we can do it,
- --because LOVE seeks the Good of the other just as God does with us...
- ...every single day—
- -always treating US better than we deserve,
- -setting the example for our treatment twd one another
- ??--How are we doing at living-out these Character Qualities/Attitudes IN OUR OWN LIVES?
- --at home,
- --on the road, everywhere...
- --BUT especially here AT CHURCH...

(personal testimony of God convicting me of lacking gentleness/respect in dealing with people online and how repentance brought fruitful interaction with non-believers)
