

JEREMIAH 30: 16







JEREMIAH 30: 17

- Not that they Can't heal: They can
- Not that they Don't heal: They do
- Not that they Won't heal: They WILL



2 KEY PRINCIPLES

- 1. God wants us to heal, He say He will.
- 2. He uses our wounds to make us healthy



HOW GOD USES OUR WOUNDS TO AFFECT US

1. To get our attention (C.S. Lewis: "Pain is God's Megaphone")

- 2. To redefine or redirect our priorities (Haggai 1:4-11)
- 3. To draw us to Himself (2 Chron. 15:4)



- 4. To discipline or correct us (Romans 13:24)
- 5. To Strengthen our faith (1 Peter 1:7)
